The Macy mine is located on the south shore of Alice Arm, about 3 miles south-southwest of the community of Alice Arm. The mine was in operation in 1917 when the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company, Limited was mining barren quartz for use as a flux at the company's Anyox smelter. The workings consist chiefly of open cuts.
