White quartz veins, each several feet wide, are sparsely mineralized with pyrite, chalcopyrite, and some sphalerite. The veins cut argillaceous quartzite and greywacke.

This showing is located at the 750 foot elevation on the west slope of Widdzech (Table) Mountain, 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ miles southeast of the community of Alice Arm.

The Beverley group of 5 claims was staked by Louis Reynolds, of Alice Arm. Exploration work by the owner was reported in 1923 and 1931. The workings include open cuts and 2 crosscut adits; the main adit is over 200 feet in length.
