HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the north side of the Illiance River about 200 yards below Theophilus (Copper) Creek, 5½ miles east of the community of Alice Arm.

This group, described under the name "Ingraham's Claims", is thought to have consisted of 3 claims, the Supreme and Supreme Nos. 1 & 2. The claims were owned by Messrs. Ingraham, Morley, McPhee, and Saunders in 1923. Exploration work was done in a short crosscut adit driven into the dyke.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A wide porphyritic dyke strikes northeasterly about parallel with the river. The workings expose quartz and calcite seams running in all directions in the dyke rock. These are fairly well mineralized with galena and, in addition, there are patches of fine-grained galena occurring in the dyke itself. A sample of the galena assayed a trace in gold and 11 ounces a ton in silver.
