The lowest exposed mineral showing is a zone of quartz gashes in argillite. A few hundred feet higher is a quartz vein several feet wide sparsely mineralized with pyrite and galena.

These showings are located on the north side of the Illiance River about a mile below Theophilus (Copper) Creek, 4½ miles east of the community of Alice Arm.

The Copper Creek group consisted of 5 claims, the Black Diamond Nos. 1 and 2, War Eagle, Little Giant, and Liberty, owned by G.W. Morley and associates, of Alice Arm, in 1921. Exploration work was done in open cuts on the vein.
