DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Two quartzose brecciated zones 15 to 20 feet wide were exposed by ground sluicing. These are mineralized with pyrite, markasite, sparse galena, and sphalerite. Assays of two samples were reported: one assayed gold, 0.02 ounce a ton; silver, 2.0 ounces a ton; the other assayed gold, trace; silver, 0.6 ounces a ton; lead, 1.6%; zinc, 2.8%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Three Mile property is on the Illiance River about 3 miles from its mouth.

Two claims, the Three Mile and Three Mile Extension, were owned by John Hauber, of Alice Arm, in 1930. Exploration work to 1930 was done in 2 adits; a crosscut adit on the east bank was driven 200 feet; an adit on the west bank was driven 20 feet. Further prospecting and stripping by ground sluicing was carried out in 1931.
