On the Silver Bell claim the mineralized zone is up to 15 feet wide and consists of stringers of quartz in argillaceous rock. The quartz carries pyrite, sphalerite, and galena. The only sulphide of any abundance is sphalerite. On the Lone Star group a large quartz vein up to 20 feet wide is locally mineralized with sphalerite and pyrite. The vein has been traced by open cuts and adits for a distance of 1,500 feet or more. It is very sparsely mineralized with sulphides. The vein lies in argillite near the contact with a stock of augite porphyrite.

These showings are located at about the 700 foot elevation in the vicinity of Morley Creek on the south side of Wilauks (McGrath) Mountain, 3 miles east of the community of Alice Arm. The Silver Bell claim adjoins and lies southwest of the Lone Star group.

The Silver Bell claim was owned from about 1918 by A. Clary. Annual assessment work, in open cuts and a short adit, was carried out for several years.

The Lone Star group consisted of 5 claims, the Lone Star No. 2, Clipper, Silver Standard, and Silver Standard Nos. 1 and 2. These claims were owned by G.W. Morley & associates from about 1918. Exploration work was carried out in open cuts and a short adit.

Mayfair Moly Mines Ltd. acquired 180 claims, covering all of Wilauks mountain, in 1966.
