DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are greenstones, argillites, and porphyry. Two veins have been found. On the S. and D. Fr. a vein from 8 to 20 feet wide has been traced for 600 feet in a westerly direction and lies between porphyry on the north and greenstone on the south. Vein filling consists of quartz and silicified schists, mineralized with pyrite and arsenopyrite. Assays reportedly gave values as high as \$20 per ton in silver and gold combined. A second vein, striking northwesterly across the Daly claim, has been traced for several hundred feet. This vein is reported to have yielded high assays in silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at about the 4,200 foot elevation on the west side of Bear River Ridge, about a mile southeast of the south end of Long Lake.

Four claims, the Daly, Sullivan, S. and D. Fraction and Mahood Fraction were located by Patrick Daly in 1910. The Daly and Sullivan (Lots 3684 and 3685) were Crown-granted to Messrs. McDonald and Winkler in 1917. Mahood Mines, Limited acquired the fractional claims and a one-half interest in the Daly and Sullivan Crown-granted claims in about 1920. The company name was changed in 1922 to American Mining and Milling Company, Limited. Work done on the showings is reported to consist of open cutting, and one adit of unknown length.
