## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by a belt of quartz porphyry and quartz diorite dykes that runs northwesterly across the north end of Long Lake. A quartz vein on the property is reported to contain lead and iron pyrites and carries values in silver and gold.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Sunrise group and the Edith claims lie east of the north end of Long Lake at about the 3,500 foot elevation. The Lois claim lies about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the north at about the same elevation and adjoins the Spider property on the south.

The Edith and Lois claims (Lots 3686 and 3687 respectively) were Crown-granted to J.M. McDonald and F.C. Winkler in 1917. The Sunrise group of 4 claims was acquired by G. Mahood and associates, who formed Mahood Mines, Limited in March 1920. The company name was changed in 1922 to American Mining & Milling Company, Limited. The company continued to hold the Sunrise group, now consisting of 2 claims, and acquired a half interest in the Edith and Lois claims. Some open cutting was reported on the Sunrise claims.
