HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at about the 2,500 foot elevation on the west side of the Bear River about $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Stewart. The claims lay north of and adjoining the Prince John property.

The Red Bluff claims, owned by Messrs. Nesbitt, Archie, and Irwin, were under bond in 1923 to C.A. MacKenzie, who also held an option on the Prince John group. The Prince John Mining Company, Limited was formed to acquire both properties. In 1923 the company drove a 182 foot long crosscut on the Red Bluff group. The crosscut approached the mineralized zone at a small angle; the last 50 feet, being in the mineralized belt, showed some stringers of mineralized quartz but these didn't occur with sufficient frequency to be of commercial value at that time.

The Red Bluff Nos. 1-3 claims (Lots 4396, 4397, and 4401) were Crown-granted to the company in 1926. No further work was reported and the company charter was surrendered in 1944.
