These showings are located at the 3,500 foot elevation north of the headwaters of Lydden Creek, some 11 miles north-northeast of Stewart. The Red Cliff Extension claims lie northwest of the Red Cliff and Big Casino properties, the intervening ground being covered by the Bull Frog and Emily Edith claims.

The Red Cliff Extension Mining Company, Limited was formed in October 1909 to acquire the Red Cliff Extension, Copper Hill No. 1, and Combination Fraction claims. Work by the company included a series of open cuts, and one adit 80 feet long.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The underlying rocks are a slightly schistose variety of the Bear River greenstones. These are cut by a zone of fissuring running nearly east-west. At the upper open cut the fissured country rock is largely replaced, for a width of 12 feet, with quartz, often red and jaspery, and calcite, and carries some pyrite, and small quantities of galena and chalcopryrite. The lower open cut exposes a small lens of good chalcopryrite ore.
