DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A tongue of granitic rock of the Coast Range intrusives cuts argillites of the Hazelton group on the north side of Strohn Creek. A quartz vein from 3 to 6 feet wide, lying in the granitic intrusive, is mineralized with molybdenite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on Strohn Creek about 6 miles east of the Bear River Pass, some 21 miles northeast of Stewart.

Three claims were staked on the showings by the Fitzgerald Bros. in about 1917. Several hundred pounds of the ore was transported to Stewart. This ore contained an estimated 6% molybdenite.
