DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The formation consists of grey, green, and purple tuffs of the Hazelton group. Between elevations of 4,800 and 6,000 feet is a small area of intrusive porphyritic granodiorite. Three quartz replacement zones from 2 to 15 feet wide strike northwesterly and dip southwest. They are generally conformable to the strike and dip of the formation. Mineralization consists of sphalerite, galena, pyrite, and, locally, some chalcopyrite in irregular patches, blebs, and seams in a quartzose gangue. The most northerly zone, for a distance of 160 feet, shows intensive quartz replacement and fair mineralization across widths of 7 to 14 feet. A selected sample of the best mineralization found in an open cut across this zone assayed: Gold, 0.03 ounce a ton; silver, 2.03 ounces a ton; lead, 13.3%; zinc, 6.0%.
