DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Mineralization occurs in a shear zone along the contact between folded volcanics and limestone. Within the zone a quartz vein, 4 to 8 feet wide, is erratically mineralized with tetrahedrite. Sparse tetrahedrite mineralization was also found in reticulated quartz stringers in the limestone foot-wall.
