DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by a series of green tuffs cut by quartz porphyry sills of the Premier type. The whole series strikes about north and dips 45° west. The showing at the creek occurs at a tuff-quartz porphyry contact and consists of stringers of pyrite and galena in a quartz gangue. The showing near the crosscut adit consists of a northerly striking silicified zone 8 to 10 feet wide in greenstone. Throughout the zone are small veins of pure quartz running in all directions. The whole zone is mineralized with pyrite and apparently carries some silver sulphides, mainly argentite.
