Some very high-grade silver values were found on the surface at the contact of argillite with granitic rock of the Coast Range intrusives.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the north side of the west arm of Salmon glacier. The claims lie on the south slope of what was locally known as August Mountain, and are about a mile south of the St. Eugene group.

It is not known when the Hollywood Nos. 1-8 claims were located. Cronholm-Bartholf Mines, Limited was formed in December 1922 to develop the property. Over 200 feet of tunnel was reported driven in the summer of 1923. In 1924 the company name was changed to Hollywood Mines, Limited. The Hollywood claims Nos. 1-11 inclusive (Lots 4485-4495) were Crown-granted in 1925. Further work was reported on the property during the summer of 1925.
