The country rocks are mainly dark green flows, tuffs, agglomerates and breccia, intruded by syenite porphyry. The claims cover 2.8 strike miles of the same formation as found at the Granduc mine. Chalcopyrite mineralization has been found at several localities and occurs in both the volcanics and the porphyry. At one showing the chalcopyrite mineralization is associated with magnetite.

Newmont Mining Corporation explored the area in September 1959 and August 1960. The showings were staked by K.G. Sanders and R. Zielinski for Granduc Mines Ltd. in 1961, but the claims were allowed to lapse by Granduc without doing any kind of exploration work other than geological mapping.

The Unuk claims Nos. 1 to 50 were restaked in the name of W.J. Worrall, of Vancouver, in April 1964 and transferred to Tuksi Mining & Development Company Limited. Jodee Explorations Limited optioned the property in May 1964 and began a diamond drilling program. A total of \$50,000 was spent in exploration work on the property. By error the assessment work was not recorded and the claims lapsed. The ground was restaked by the company and 4 additional claims were added. Under the agreement with Jodee Explorations the 54 claims were transferred to a newly formed company Unuk River Copper Mines Ltd. in March 1965.
