DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

An intrusive quartz porphyry is exposed over a circular area approximately 1,600 feet in diameter. An annular ring of syenite, hornfels and amphibolite, approximately 4,000 feet in diameter, surrounds the granodiorite. Surrounding this mixed zone are regionally metamorphosed sediments and volcanics of Triassic age. Molybdenite occurs in numerous quartz stringers that cut the hornfels, syenite and, to a lesser extent, the quartz porphyry. In the initial drilling, the only important mineralization encountered occurred in silicified hornfels in contact with quartz porphyry: in one drill hole a 180 foot section averaged greater than 0.15% MoS₂.
