The material noted in the medial moraine consists of fine grained leucogranite with veins and disseminated rosettes of coarse molybdenite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

Three molybdenite occurrences are noted on Map 7-1959 in the vicinity of Chutine Lake. One occurrence is located about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile east of the lake; another is located on the east side of the Chutine River about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of the north end of the lake; the third occurrence, consisting of float in a medial moraine, is located on a glacier about 4 miles west of the north end of the lake.

Kennco Explorations, (Western) Ltd. was reported to have located claims west of the north end of the lake in 1959. The showings were examined by the company but were not further investigated.
