## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Skarn mineralization containing chalcopyrite, pyrite, pyrrhotite, magnetite, and specular hematite is developed adjacent to a diorite-granodiorite stock 1 mile in diameter.

Associated minerals or products of value - Iron.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation on the southwest side of Tahltan Lake, 18 miles west of Telegraph Creek.

The VB 1-42 claims were owned in 1974 by Amax Exploration, Inc. Work included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 21 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (314 samples) over 10 line-miles covering VB 1-30.
