Chalcopyrite and pyrite occurs as disseminations in altered fragmental andesites and in adjacent intrusive rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 4,000 foot elevation on the east side of More Creek, 6 miles south of Hankin Peak and approximately 56 miles south-southeast of Telegraph Creek.

The Little Les 1-24 claims were held in 1971 by Newmont Mining Corporation of Canada Limited. Work included geological mapping, a geochemical stream sediment survey, and diamond drilling in 2 holes totalling 170 feet on Little Les 3.
