Magnetite and chalcopyrite were found in fracture fillings of shear zones. The host rock is granodiorite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 8 miles east of Galore Creek at elevations of 4,500 to 6,600 feet.

A group of 126 claims were held in 1965 by Phelps Dodge Corporation of Canada, Limited. Work included geological mapping, and the drilling and blasting of 12 trenches totalling 1,305 feet.
