**DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT** 

Basic volcanic rocks are intruded by subvolcanic intrusions from which felsic volcanic rocks were erupted. These rocks are overlain by clastic sedimentary rocks, possibly of Cretaceous age. Pyrite and molybdenite are associated with felsic volcanic rocks.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between elevations of 4,500 and 5,500 feet 6 miles south of Eddontenajon Lake and some 56 miles south of Dease Lake.

The Ram 1-10 claims were owned in 1974 by Ecstall Mining Limited. Geological mapping, and a geochemical survey comprising 28 silt samples covering Ram 6, 8-10, and 30 soil samples covering Ram 7-10 was carried out during the year.
