This property is located at the 3,875 foot elevation on the east shore, near the south end of a small unnamed lake, containing an island, about 2 miles east of Halfmoon Lake and 11 miles southeast of the north end of Dease Lake.

Tournagain Mining Explorations Ltd. staked the Jay 11-14 claims. Approximately 1½ line-miles of magnetometer survey was carried out during 1970. The American Smelting and Refining Company optioned the claims in December 1970. Geological mapping, and a magnetometer survey over 9 line-miles, was carried out in 1971.
