Massive chalcopyrite, pyrrhotite, and pyrite occur along the contact between granodiorite and marble.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located at the 5,000 foot elevation between Eagle and Little Eagle Rivers, 11 miles east of Dease Lake.

The Mac group of 20 claims was staked by K. Willison, of Watson Lake, in about 1967. Jupiter Explorations Ltd. acquired the Mac 1-16 claims and during 1969 carried out electromagnetic and geochemical soil surveys.
