HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately the 4,500 feet elevation, 4 miles southeast of Halfmoon Lake, 8 miles east of Dease Lake.

The Cop 1-36 claims were held in 1972 by Union Miniere Explorations and Mining Corporation Limited. Work included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 20 line-miles, induced polarization and resistivity surveys over 2.4 line miles, and a geochemical soil survey (504 samples) covering all claims.
