DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite and nickeliferous sulphides occur in serpentine and peridotite on the GB 45 claim. A quartz vein adjacent to the sulphide zone carries similar sulphides. Some chrysotile veinlets are present.

Associated minerals or products of value - **Nickel, asbestos.**

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 5 miles north of the north end of Cry Lake, about 50 miles northeast of the community of Dease Lake.

The GB 1-65 claims, staked by Gordon Blaney, were acquired by Minex Development Ltd. During 1970 magnetometer and geochemical surveys were made over about 25 miles of line. A small amount of trenching was done.
