DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Clusters of coarse molybdenite and chalcopyrite occur in two parallel quartz veins 5 feet apart in quartz monzonite. The veins were sampled along the best mineralized sections over a width of 1.7 feet and combined length of 29 feet; the weighted assay was 1.42% copper and 0.20% molybdenite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Molybdenum.
