HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the Kehlechoa River, some 50 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

The TNA group of 40 recorded claims was held by Julian Mining Co. Ltd. Work during 1963 included a magnetometer survey over 20,000 feet of line, a geochemical soil survey, and 80 feet of light diamond drilling.
