HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 50 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

Pelly Copper Corporation Ltd., incorporated November 1968, acquired the 8 claim HC group and the adjacent CM group (104 I/3, Cu 4).

Bowser Resources Ltd., incorporated July 1969, acquired 488 claims in the area, including the Bold group which covers this showing. In January 1971 Empire Metals Corporation Ltd. acquired a 68.2% interest in the company. Work on the property in 1971 included an airborne magnetometer survey, a geochemical survey, and diamond drilling.
