DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The North showing comprises bornite and chalcocite finely disseminated along a shear zone in Takla (?) lavas. The width of the copper-bearing zone varies from 3 to 15 feet.

Associated minerals or products of value

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 50 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

An option, held by Leitch Gold Mines Limited on the Ride group, lapsed by default in 1969.

Pelly Copper Corporation Ltd., incorporated November 1968, acquired the 18 claim CM and 8 claim HC groups. A geological survey and line cutting was reported in 1969.

Bowser Resources Ltd., incorporated July 1969, acquired 488 claims in the Bonus, Bold, Boldex, Pay, Sec, Sue, Joy, Bow, etc. groups, and an option on 18 adjacent claims. In January 1971 Empire Metals Corporation Ltd. acquired a 68.2% interest in the company. Exploration work during 1971 included a detailed geological survey on the Bonus 1-4 claims, geochemical and airborne magnetometer surveys, and 966 feet of diamond drilling in 4 holes.
