HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the west side of Gnat Creek, 16 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

Chapparal Mines Ltd. discovered the showing in 1970 and staked the Bell 1-50 claims. Work during 1971 included an airborne magnetometer survey of all claims, an induced polarization survey, a geochemical soil survey over 45 line-miles, and diamond drilling in 2 holes totalling 525 feet.
