DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are situated along the contact of the Hotailuh batholith which intrudes Upper Triassic volcanic rocks. Chalcopyrite with minor sphalerite, galena, and molybdenite are developed in northerly trending sets of fractures. Locally fractures have argillic and quartz-sericite alteration envelopes.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 3,400 foot elevation straddling the British Columbia Railway line, 5 miles north of the Stikine River crossing and 28 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

The BCR 1-38 and SS 1-34 claims were owned in 1974 by Stikine Services Ltd. During the year Quintana Minerals Corporation carried out geological mapping, and 1,430 feet of percussion drilling in 15 holes.
