Chrysotile occurs in veinlets up to 1 inch in width in peridotite. Fine-grained disseminated chalcopyrite and pyrite also occur in the peridotite.

Associated minerals or products of value - **Copper.**

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 4,000 to 5,000 feet east of Serpentine Lakes and south of Eaglehead Lake, 30 miles east of Dease Lake.
