HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,000 feet elevation east of Glacial Lake, 27 miles southeast of Dease Lake.

The Wolf 1-18 claims, owned by Kol Lovang, were under option to El Paso Mining and Milling Company in 1972. Work during the year included geological mapping and a geochemical soil survey (297 samples) covering Wolf 1-5, 14, and 16.
