Small amounts of nickel, as millerite, occur disseminated in serpentized peridotite. Values range from 0.19 to 0.25 nickel over a large area.

HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on Two Mile Creek, 4 miles south of its junction with the Turnagain River and some 27 miles east-southeast of Dease Lake.

The Lux 1-4 claims, owned by F. Glauque, were under option to Scurry-Rainbow Oil Limited. During 1970 the geology of the claims was mapped, and the showings sampled. The option was subsequently dropped.
