Quartz stringers in quartz porphyry. Gold values up to 0.27 ounce per ton across a width of 40 feet reported in 1931.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Thibert Creek, below Berry Creek, about 5 miles west of the north end of Dease Lake.

The Keystone group of 8 claims was owned in the early 1930's by Homer Ficklin, of Porter Landing. Open cutting and stripping was reported in 1931 and some further work in 1933.
