HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 4,400 foot elevation between the headwaters of Pallen and Itsillitu Creeks, about 22 miles southwest of Dease Lake.

The Disco 1-95 and Chopper 1-35 claims were staked by Newmont Mining Corporation of Canada Limited in August 1970 as a result of a regional program. Work on the showings during 1970 and 1971 included geological mapping, magnetometer, induced polarization, and geochemical soil surveys, and trenching.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Copper and molybdenum mineralization occurs as fracture fillings and disseminations within granodiorite and in volcanic rock near the intrusive contact. Eleven separate showings have been located.
