HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the north bank of the Stikine River about 9 miles upstream from Telegraph Creek.

The Pinto 1-38 claims were held in 1970 by Gypsy Queen Explorations Ltd. Work during the year included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over approximately 3 line-miles covering Pinto 15 and 16, a geochemical soil survey covering Pinto 15 and 16, and trenching.
