DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is generally underlain by Triassic rhyolite to basalt olcanics and volcanic sediments and intruded by granodiorite, iorite, and monzonite stocks, and various dykes. Shearing and racturing is extensive in the country rocks. Mineralization is ssentially chalcopyrite, pyrite, and some pyrrhotite associated ith epidote-chlorite-actinolite alteration. The country rocks are enerally chloritized and weakly serpentinized. The observed ineralization and the copper anomalies are peripheral to a small ranodiorite pluton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located on the north side of the Hackett River at Copper Creek, about 27 miles northwest of Telegraph Creek.

Brikon Explorations Limited in 1955 optioned 8 claims from F.C. Callison and subsequently staked 192 adjacent claims. Work during 1955-56 included trenching, and 490 feet of diamond drilling in 4 holes.

Skyline Explorations Ltd. held the GO group of 78 claims covering the showings in 1969. Work during the year included a geological survey, soil sampling, and trenching.
