Upper Triassic volcanic rocks are cut by small intrusive bodies containing disseminated pyrite and chalcopyrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 4,000 foot elevation near the head of the Hackett River, approximately 6 miles southwest of Kennicott Lake and 65 miles southwest of Dease Lake.

The VI 1-51 claims were held by Sumitomo Metal Mining Canada Ltd. A geochemical soil survey (331 samples) covering 22 claims was carried out in 1972.
