Asbestos occurs in serpentinized peridotite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 3,000 foot elevation on the east side of Dease Lake, 10 miles north of Dease Lake village.

The Bak 1-38, WP 1-14, and Happy 1 and 2 claims were held by the American Smelting and Refining Company in 1971. Work during the year included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 21.1 line-miles covering all Bak and WP claims, and diamond drilling in 6 holes totalling 2,200 feet on WP 1-4.
