HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the east side of Whiting Lake.

The Tess 1-32 claims were staked for NRD Mining Ltd. in September 1972. Work during 1973 included a geochemical soil survey (190 samples) on the westerly claims, and 35 rock samples collected from irregularly spaced sites on the easterly claims.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Pyritic, argillic, and silicified volcanic and intrusive rocks of the Late Cretaceous and Early Tertiary Sloko Group form a large, rusty weathering zone that contains minor chalcopryrite and malachite on Vance Creek.
