DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Fractured quartz diorite and diorite is cut by granitic dykes, quartz veins, and a major shear zone. Molybdenite mineralization is more intense in the areas of greatest fracturing.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located 7 miles southeast of Tunjony Lake 85 miles southeast of Atlin.

The LC 1-8 and Peter 1-8 claims were owned in 1969 by Geophoto Services Ltd.

During the year the claims were geologically mapped and an area 350 by 550 feet was trenched and sampled.
