HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located near Pavey station on Bennett Lake. The main tunnel is at the 3,600 foot elevation.

The earliest work reported on the property was done in 1915 and 1916 by the Silver Queen and Ruby Mines Company, which was formed in 1915 by New York interests. Development work was done in a crosscut tunnel which was reported in 1916, to be in over 500 feet. Some ore was shipped in 1916.

No further activity was reported until 1933 when the Alaska Juneau Gold Mining Company carried out exploration work on the Silver Queen group, then owned by J.D. McDougal & associates.

Premier Mining Corporation Ltd. held the property in 1970 as the Dick 1-40 and Old 1-6 claims. During the year an aeromagnetic survey was carried out over 64 line miles covering all the claims. The company name was changed in 1971 to Premier Resources Ltd. Work during the year included geological mapping and trenching on Old 5 and Dick 6 claims.
