DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A shear zone about 16 feet wide strikes east-west and dips north at 45°. The zone consists of alternating bands of quartz and talcose matter; the quartz contains pyrite carrying values in gold and silver, while some lead and antimony is present in places. The country rocks are granites of the Coast Intrusions.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the west side of Bennett lake, about six miles from the town of Bennett. The four unsurveyed claims were owned by Messrs. Whitefield and Hildebrand. Development work, done in about 1901, consists of a 110 foot long adit driven from a point about 30 feet above the lake level.
