DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Two quartz veins lie in a greenish schistose formation which outcrops on the south shore of Willison Bay. The formation is badly distorted and indications are that the veins have no continuity. The quartz carries good gold values. A few pieces picked from one of the open cuts assayed: gold, 1.58 ounces a ton; silver, 7 ounces a ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This occurrence is located at the south end of Atlin Lake. In 1918 Mrs. Callaghan held 6 claims, extending south from Willison Bay along the west side of Hobo Creek to the Laverdiere property. The only work reported is some open cutting near the shore of Willison Bay.
