DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The formation consists of quartzite, gneiss and schist of uncertain age but considered to be mainly pre-Permian. Granitic rocks of the Coast Intrusions outcrop on the western portion of White Moose mountain and were encountered underground in a branch drift from No. 1 vein. At least five veins are reported to outcrop on the property. They all strike northwesterly, dip steeply, and vary in width from 1 to 8 feet. The white quartz vein filling is sparsely mineralized with pyrite, galena, and sphalerite. Occasional particles of pyrite and native gold occur. A sample across 14 inches in the face of the drift on No. 1 vein assayed: gold, trace; silver, 1.6 oz/ton; lead, 0.6%; zinc, trace.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located between elevations of 3,650 and 4,700 feet on the east side of White Moose mountain, which rises above the west shore of Taku Arm. In 1900 the property was owned by Messrs. Rupert and Johnson, who had apparently been prospecting and developing the showings for several years previously.

Title to a large group of claims on White Moose mountain was acquired by Messrs. Partridge & Edgerton, and prospecting and development work was carried out during 1914, however, it is not known if the Rupert group was included in these claims.

Development work, apparently done prior to 1900, consists of 315 feet of drift and crosscut on No. 1 vein, and a second adit of unknown length.
