DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A vein of banded quartz and slate strikes N20°W and where exposed has a width of about 25 feet. A 35 foot adit was driven on a 12 inch cross vein striking N55°E.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the east side of Taku Arm, Tagish Lake, and adjoins the Engineer property on the north.

Seven claims and fractions, the Sweepstake 1-6 and Golden Hope, were owned in 1918 by John Dunham and B.J. Nichol. Work to that date had been done in open cuts and a 35 foot adit. The Sweepstake 1-3 claims (Lots 3283-3285) were Crown-granted to the above owners in 1919.

Sweepstakes Mining Corporation, of Delaware, held the property in 1927; the Sweepstake 4-6 claims (Lots 4672-4674) were Crown-granted to the company during the year.
