DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A four foot wide vein of quartz is sparingly mineralized with galena, zinc-blende, and some grey copper. Along one wall there is a narrow vein of high-grade ore.

Map 19-1957 shows a copper-nickel occurrence in the vicinity.

This property is located on the west side of the Wann River, about half way between Edgar Lake and Taku Arm. It is not known when the property was staked, however, some work was done prior to 1913. The Brownie Nos. 1, 3, 4 and 5 claims were owned by Messrs. Dunham, Nichol, Kerlaw, and Gilmore in 1918. Development work consists of open cuts and a short adit.
