DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The formation consists mainly of chloritic and sericitic schists, quartzites, and limestones. Two veins have been discovered; the upper one is from 4 to 5 feet wide, strikes N70°W, and dips southwest at about 80 degrees. The vein consists mainly of quartz, which is sparsely mineralized with galena, pyrite, and occasional particles of native gold. The other vein contains only occasional particles of pyrite and iron oxide.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the east slope of the mountain between Birch and Boulder Creeks, about 1,650 feet above the lower end of Surprise Lake, some 10 miles northeast of Atlin.

In 1904 the White Star group of 3 claims was owned by Captain Armstrong, of Atlin. Development work to this date consisted of open cuts, a crosscut 25 feet to the vein, and a drift on the vein for 60 feet. In 1910 the property was owned by Wm. Hawthorne, however, no further development work has been reported.
